Materials list

Watercolor Brushes:

number 12 Round brush
number 8 Round brush
number 6 Round brush
number 2 Rigger brush – Long Bristle
number 2 Round brush – Short Bristle
Flat brush – 1 inch wide

Paint:

Windsor Newton Pan set (pan of 12) or **Yarka** Pan set (pan of 12)

Paper:

Arches or **Windsor Newton** 140 pound cold press, 9x12 or 14x18

Supplies:

*Pencil
Masking tape – 1 inch
Kneaded Eraser
*Paper Towels
*Water Container (can be an old jar)
*Medium size plastic palette, (disposable palette paper or even Styrofoam plate work fine)
*Medium size foam board to tape down paper
Miskit masking fluid, large needle for **Miskit** applications
Old toothbrush
Exactor knife
*Q-tips

**these items are available at the studio at no cost*

If you already have watercolor paints that you have been working with, that's fine, just bring them as they can be pan or tube sets. If you are a first time painter, it's great to start with the Windsor or Yarka pan set.

Pro-white paint comes in a jar and is great to have as time goes on. Also Paynes Gray is an awesome color to have, and it comes in a tube. However, all you need to start is the pan set as stated above.
